Range of Services

Repeat Prescriptions

Requests for Repeat Prescriptions must be made 2 working days before collection. For accuracy and efficiency please submit computer generated repeat prescriptions slip at all times. Phone requests for repeat prescription will not be accepted unless the patient is house bound. Please note all prescriptions are to be ordered by patients only. This can be done either on line or by coming into the practice. The pharmacists will not be able to order prescriptions on patient's behalf unless they have been authorised to do so.

Request for Test Results

All requests for test results must be made between 2.30 and 4pm. But if you need to know about a pregnancy test, you can ask any time. But you have to come in person to collect this results.

Non NHS Services

A fee is payable for all non NHS work. This includes such as Medical Examinations, travel/sport/employment, medical records for insurance companies or solicitors and all private letters. All these non-NHS services are completed at the doctors discretion and a charge will be made.

Doctors Training in General Practice

The practice usually has the benefit of one or more doctors training in general practice. After substantial time spent working in hospital, they spend a year with us before entering independent practice. They are available for consultation in the same way as the other doctors in the practice.

Medical Students

Occasionally we may have medical students who sit with the doctor or nurse during consultations. You will be notified in advance if a student is going to be present and have the choice of requesting that the student leaves before the consultation begins.

Chaperone Policy

All patients have the opportunity of being examined in the presence of a chaperone when an intimate examination is carried out. The chaperone will be a member of staff or an interpreter. Family members cannot stand as interpreters by law. If you know in advance that you would like to have someone with you, please inform reception at the time of making your appointment.

Walk in Centres

Walk in centres offer fast access to health advice and treatment. They are open to anyone on a drop-in basis. They provide minor treatments, information about local health services and self-help advice. They are mainly nurse-led.
